This letter is written on behalf of Ms. Staker.

Ms. Staker has been an invaluable resource to our organization. We care for neglected and abused "exotic" animals that people have tried to make into pets, including many Australian species. As Americans, we do not have the training to properly care for animals of Australia as pets yet they are readily available for the public to purchase through the exotic pet trade. If it weren't for Lynda's knowledge, time and concern we would not have been able to save many of the animals that have come into our facility.
